

## **THE SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL**

### **B3001 Station Hill and B3001 Waverley Lane, Farnham Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2020**

Surrey County Council propose to make the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of B3001 Station Hill and B3001 Waverley Lane, Farnham that is comprised within the level crossing and for a distance of 20m either side. This Temporary Traffic Order is required to enable Network Rail to carry out inspections, installations and/or maintenance and repair works to the level crossing. These works are anticipated to be carried out within 28.5 hours of the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Order, which commences on the 27 September 2020; between the hours of 12:30am on 27/9/20 to 5am on 28/9/20. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for emergency vehicles, pedestrians and; dismounted cyclists and equestrians will be maintained at all times. No sole access to any property will be affected however access for local residents and businesses will be maintained via the signed vehicular diversion route which will be: Eastbound: A31 Farnham By-Pass (W/B), Weydon Lane, Wrecclesham Road, The Street, Wrecclesham Hill, Echo Barn Lane, Shortheath Road, Ridgeway Road, Firgrove Hill, Great Austins, Tilford Road, Menin Way and Waverley Lane. Westbound: Waverley Lane, Menin Way, Tilford Road, Great Austin's, Firgrove Hill, Ridgeway Road, Shortheath Road, Echo Barn Lane, Wrecclesham Hill, The Street, Wrecclesham Road, Weydon Lane, Farnham By-Pass (E/B), Shepherd and Flock Roundabout and Farnham By-Pass (W/B).

### **Public Footpath 103 (Farnham) Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2020 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Section 14(1)**

The Surrey County Council Public Footpath 103 (Farnham) Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2020 was made to protect public safety due to construction traffic crossing the public footpath while moving between a construction site and site compound. The Order came into operation on 6 March 2020

It was due to expire on 16 September 2020. It has been continued in force by the Secretary of State for Transport until 15 September 2021 or until completion of the works, whichever is earlier.

The Order as continued will have the effect of prohibiting all traffic on foot or by any other means from entering or proceeding along part of Public Footpath 103 (Farnham) from a point 60 metres from Green Lane in an east-south-easterly direction to a point 5 metres from Green Lane. This is shown as a solid red line between point A (Grid Ref: 485741 147661) and point B (Grid Ref: 485793 148648) on the closure plan.

The temporary closure will only be in operation when appropriate road traffic signs are displayed on site by the County Council or an authorised person acting on its behalf. Access to properties will not be affected.

The alternative route from point A will be in a southerly, easterly and then northerly direction around the outside of the site compound as shown on the Order plan. The alternative route from point B will be the reverse of the above.
